Arkansas Winter Wheat Yield Forecast Unchanged from June

As of July 1, **Arkansas winter wheat** production for 2024 is forecast at 4.75 million bushels, up 27 percent from the June 1 forecast but down 49 percent from last year. Based on July 1 conditions, yield is forecast at 50 bushels per acre, unchanged from last month but 7 bushels below last year. Area for harvest, at 95,000 acres, is up 27 percent from the *Acres* report released on June 28, 2024, but down 42 percent from 2023. The July 1, 2024, *Arkansas Crop Progress and Condition* report showed 94 percent of the winter wheat crop had been harvested.

United States winter wheat production is forecast at 1.34 billion bushels, up 4 percent from the June 1 forecast and up 7 percent from 2023. Based on July 1 conditions, the United States yield is forecast at 52.0 bushels per acre, up 0.6 bushel from last month and up 1.4 bushels from last year. The area expected to be harvested for grain or seed totals 25.8 million acres, unchanged from the *Acres* report released on June 28, 2024, but up 5 percent from 2023.
