Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 3 Percent from Last Year

Arkansas hatcheries set 25.3 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending August 27, 2022, up 3 percent from the comparable week in 2021 and up slightly from the previous week.

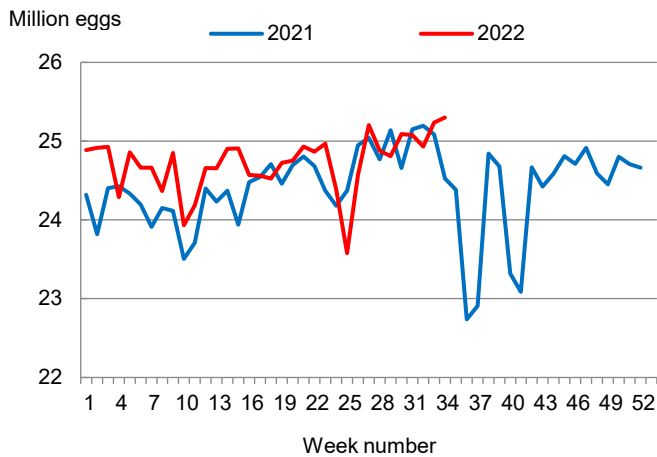
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 246 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 27, 2022, up 5 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 8 Percent

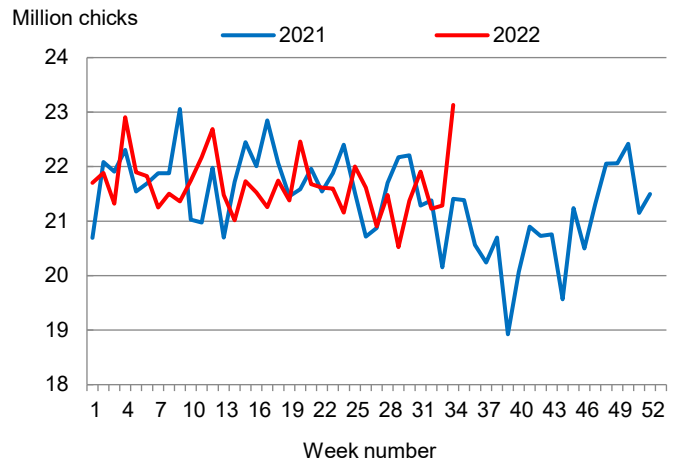
Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 23.1 million chicks during the week ending August 27, 2022, up 8 percent from the comparable week in 2021 and up 9 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 193 million chicks for meat production during the week ending August 27, 2022, up 4 percent from a year ago.
