#### **Broiler-Type Eggs Set Down 5 Percent from Last Year**


Arkansas hatcheries set 23.4 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending October 22, 2022, down 5 percent from the comparable week in 2021 and down 2 percent from the previous week.

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 235 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 22, 2022, up slightly from a year ago.


#### **Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 11 Percent**

Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 23.1 million chicks during the week ending October 22, 2022, up 11 percent from the comparable week in 2021 and up slightly from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 188 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 22, 2022, up 6 percent from a year ago.
