Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 1 Percent from Last Year

Arkansas hatcheries set 25.5 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending June 8, 2024, up 1 percent from the comparable week in 2023 but down 1 percent from the previous week.

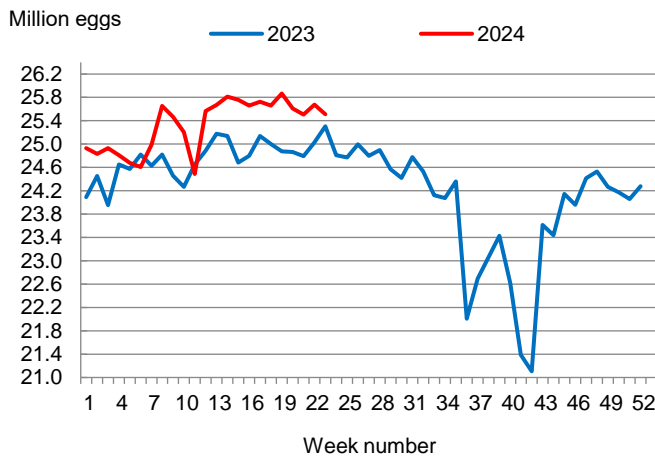
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 245 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 8, 2024, up slightly from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 6 Percent

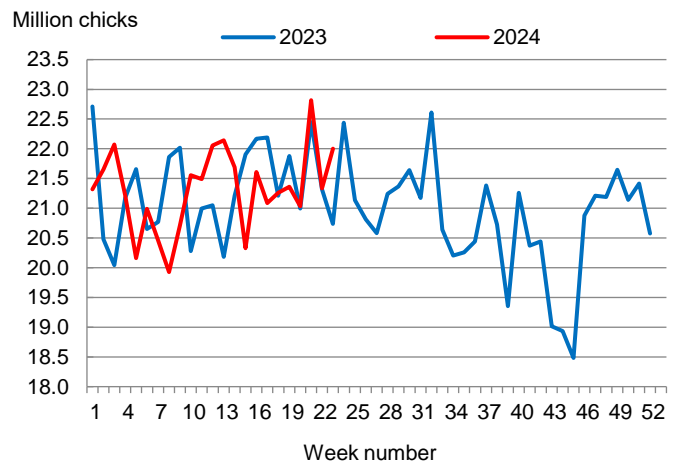
Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 22.0 million chicks during the week ending June 8, 2024, up 6 percent from the comparable week in 2023 and up 3 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 190 million chicks for meat production during the week ending June 8, 2024, up slightly from a year ago.
