Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 11 Percent from Last Year

Arkansas hatcheries set 26.0 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending November 2, 2024, up 11 percent from the comparable week in 2023 and up 2 percent from the previous week.

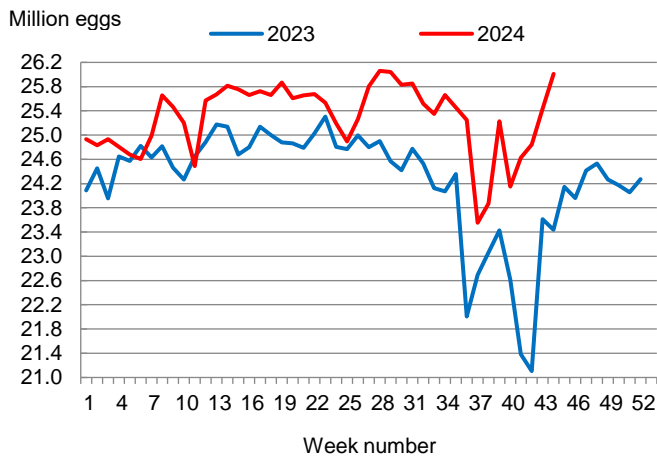
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 242 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 2, 2024, up 7 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 12 Percent

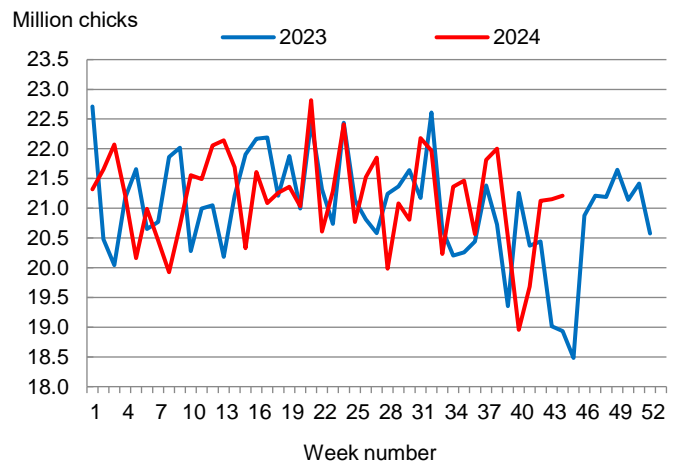
Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 21.2 million chicks during the week ending November 2, 2024, up 12 percent from the comparable week in 2023 and up slightly from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 188 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 2, 2024, up 6 percent from a year ago.
