Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 4 Percent from Last Year

Arkansas hatcheries set 25.0 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending November 9, 2024, up 4 percent from the comparable week in 2023 but down 1 percent from the previous week.

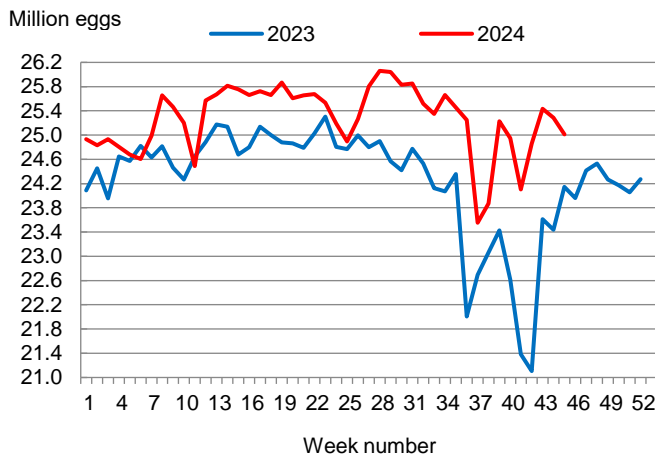
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 239 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 9, 2024, up 1 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Up 15 Percent

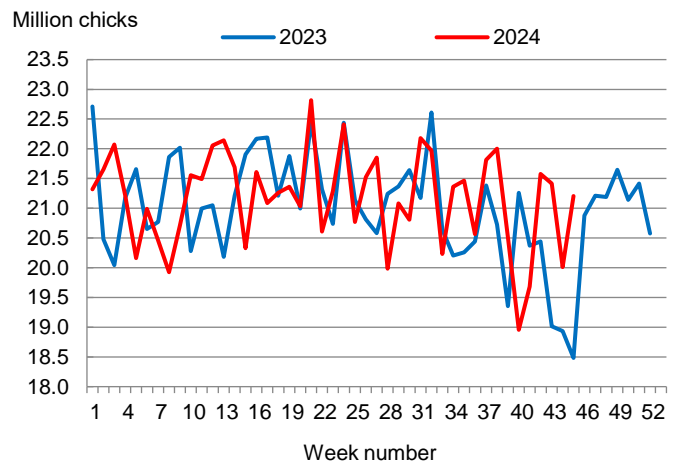
Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 21.2 million chicks during the week ending November 9, 2024, up 15 percent from the comparable week in 2023 and up 6 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 186 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 9, 2024, up 5 percent from a year ago.
