## **Pacific Region Cattle on Feed**

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 530,000 head on July 1, 2024. The inventory was 1% above last month and 2% below July 1, 2023. The inventory included 435,000 steers and steer calves, down 3% from the previous year. This group accounted for 82% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 95,000 head, up 6% from 2023. Placements in feedlots during June totaled 65,000 head, 3% below 2023. Net placements were 59,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during June totaled 54,000 head, 16% below 2023. Other disappearance totaled 6,000 head during June, 25% below 2023.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 11.3 million head on July 1, 2024. The inventory was 1% above July 1, 2023. The inventory included 6.82 million steers and steer calves, up 1% from the previous year. This group accounted for 60% of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 4.48 million head, up slightly from 2023. Placements in feedlots during June totaled 1.56 million head, 7% below 2023. Net placements were 1.51 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during June totaled 1.79 million head, 9% below 2023. Other disappearance totaled 57,000 head during June, 17% below 2023.
