## **Pacific Region Cattle on Feed**

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 515,000 head on October 1, 2024. The inventory was 1 percent below last month and 2 percent above October 1, 2023. The inventory included 420,000 steers and steer calves, up 4 percent from the previous year. This group accounted for 82 percent of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 95,000 head, down 5 percent from 2023. Placements in feedlots during September totaled 61,000 head, 42 percent above 2023. Net placements were 55,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during September totaled 60,000 head, 30 percent above 2023. Other disappearance totaled 6,000 head during September, 14 percent below 2023.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 11.6 million head on October 1, 2024. The inventory was slightly below October 1, 2023. The inventory included 7.00 million steers and steer calves, up 1 percent from the previous year. This group accounted for 60 percent of the total inventory. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 4.60 million head, down 1 percent from 2023. Placements in feedlots during September totaled 2.16 million head, 2 percent below 2023. Net placements were 2.10 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during September totaled 1.70 million head, 2 percent above 2023. Other disappearance totaled 56,000 head during September, 2 percent below 2023.
