## July Milk Production in California down 0.3 percent from last July

Milk production during July totaled 3.32 billion pounds, down 0.3 percent from July 2023 and down 1.0 percent June 2024. The number of milk cows on farms in California was 1.71 million head, down 5,000 from July 2023 and up 1,000 from June 2024. Production per cow in California averaged 1,940 pounds, unchanged pounds from July 2023 and down 20 pounds from June 2024

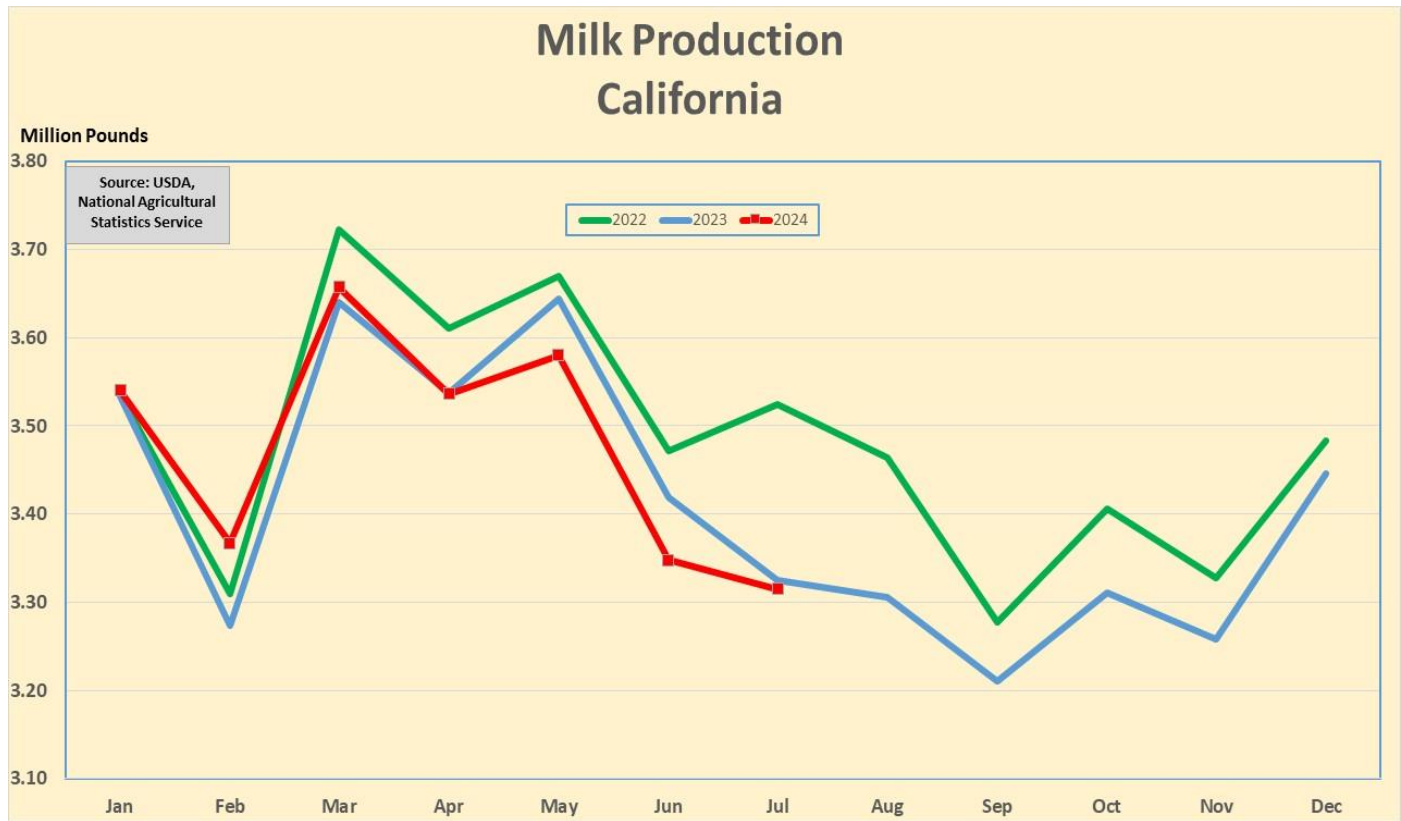
