December Milk Production in California down 6.8 percent from last December

Milk production during December totaled 3.21 billion pounds, down 6.8 percent from December 2023 and up 7.1 percent from November 2024. The number of milk cows on farms in California was 1.71 million head, down 1 thousand from December 2023 and unchanged from November 2024. Production per cow in California averaged 1,880 pounds, down 135 pounds from December 2023 and up 125 pounds from November 2024.


