State and County Profiles from the 2022 Census of Agriculture Available Now!

Sacramento, CA – March 28, 2024 – [California State and County Profiles](#) are now available. USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) released the profiles March 27, 2024. Information in the profiles includes farms and farmland, value of sales, producer demographics, top crops, internet access and more from every state and county in the nation.

“These profiles provide a 2-page summary of the 2022 Census of Agriculture data.” said Gary R. Keough, Director, USDA NASS Pacific Region.

NASS released the much-anticipated ag census at nass.usda.gov/AgCensus and in [Quick Stats](#) on Feb. 13, 2024. Ag census data spans millions of data points about America’s farms and ranches and the people who operate them. The once-every-five-years Census of Agriculture remains the only source of uniform, comprehensive, and impartial agriculture data down to the county level.
