
Freestone Peach Freezer and Dehydrator Report State Summary -- 2002 Crop Year

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FREESTONE PEACH FREEZER AND DEHYDRATOR REPORT

Information contained in this report was supplied by dry yards and freezers of Freestone peaches to fulfill reporting requirements of Sections 55601.7 and 55601.8 of the California Food and Agriculture Code. Weighted average price represents the average roadside price paid to growers and packing houses for fresh Freestone peaches used for freezing or drying. Freezers grading Freestone peaches reported approximately 5 percent as off-grade. Dry yards do not grade Freestone peaches, so there is not an off-grade percentage.
