POTATO STOCKS – FEBRUARY 1, 2025

COLORADO HIGHLIGHTS

Potato stocks in Colorado on February 1, 2025, totaled 10.80 million hundredweight, down 4 percent from the 11.30 million hundredweight stored last year. The indicated season to date disappearance totaled 10.95 million hundredweight. Potatoes in storage accounted for 50 percent of the 2024 production, compared with 54 percent a year earlier.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

Potatoes held in storage on February 1, 2025 totaled 208 million cwt, down 4 percent from February 1, 2024. Potatoes in storage accounted for 49 percent of the 2024 production, the same as a year earlier. The indicated season to date disappearance, at 212 million cwt, was down 5 percent from the same period last year. Season to date shrink and loss, at 17.1 million cwt, was down 1 percent from the same time last year. Processors in the 8 States used 110 million cwt of potatoes for the season, down 4 percent from February 2024.
