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## LOWER GUAVA SALES IN 2001

**GUAVA PRODUCTION UTILIZED FOR PROCESSING TOTALLED 15.3 MILLION POUNDS IN 2001**, down 4 percent from the previous year, according to the Hawaii Agricultural Statistics Service (HASS). Weather continued satisfactory for orchards. Hawaii island growers still cited a lack of market outlets and low prices which is being reflected by the island's decreasing guava acreage. Higher

sales and value on Kauai helped boost the overall average. Farm value was pegged at \$2.2 million for 2001.

**TOTAL ACREAGE WAS DOWN 90 ACRES TO 710**, continuing the decline that began in 1991. Harvested acreage totaled 610 acres, 70 acres less than 2000. Hawaii island accounted for most of the abandoned acreage. The majority of the acreage is on Kauai and Hawaii.

**U.S. IMPORTS OF SELECTED GUAVA PRODUCTS IN 2001** were mixed compared to 2000 (see page 4). Guava prepared or preserved imports decreased 6 percent from the previous year to 10.3 million pounds (4.7 thousand metric tons).

The Dominican Republic and Mexico supplied about 59 percent of the imports into the U.S.

Paste and puree were down 8 percent to 8.5 million pounds (3.8 thousand metric tons). Brazil, India, and Dominican Republic were the top three exporters respectively, accounting for just over 72 percent of the imports.

Guava jam imports were up 58 percent to 1.1 million pounds (507 metric tons). Brazil accounted for 44 percent of the total.



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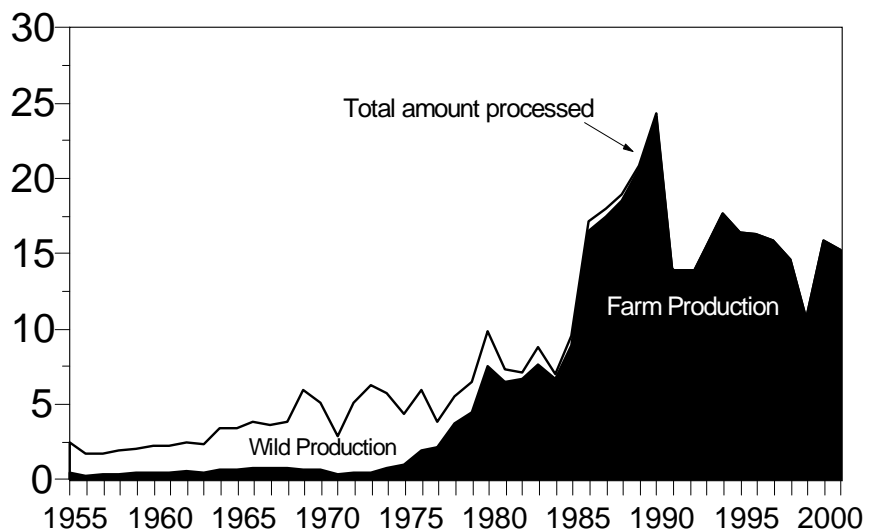
