
PAPAYAS

Hawaii fresh papaya utilization is estimated at 2.5 million pounds for March 2008, down 7 percent from February 2008, but up 7 percent from March 2007. Cumulative sales for the first quarter are estimated at 8.1 million pounds, 18 percent more than the January to March period last year.

Total in crop acreage for March is estimated at 2,020, down 3 percent from a year ago. Harvested area totaled 1,425 acres in March, up 10 percent from March last year.

Weather for March was mostly sunny and dry with some periods of heavier rainfall. Warm conditions were beneficial for fruit development and ripening. Growers were able to catch up on their regular field maintenance schedules. Increased efforts were made to control the aphid population, to limit the spread of the papaya ringspot virus during the warm and dry period.

Hawaii fresh papaya farm price for March is estimated at 50.0 cents per pound, up 16 percent (7.0 cents) from last month and 6 percent (3.0 cents) more than a year ago.
