
OCTOBER FRESH PAPAYA UP 21 PERCENT FROM LAST MONTH

Hawaii fresh papaya utilization is estimated at 3.0 million pounds for October 2008, up 21 percent from September 2008, but down 11 percent from October a year ago. January to October sales totaled 25.5 million pounds, 1 percent above the comparable period a year ago.

Sunny days, variable showers, and some trade winds characterized October's weather. Heavy rains fell on parts of the State replenishing soil moisture levels but drought conditions and water conservation measures were still in existence.

Orchards depending on natural rainfall experienced slower growth and fruit development. Dry conditions allowed farmers to keep up with normal spraying schedules. Large tracts were being cleared for future plantings.

Papaya growers are expected to receive an estimated 43.0 cents per pound for fresh fruit in October. 9 percent (4.0 cents) less than last month, but 14 percent (5.2 cents) more than October 2007.
