HAWAII 2016 VEGETABLE CROP VALUE INCREASES TO \$47.9 MILLION

The farm gate value for Hawaii's vegetable and melon crops is estimated at \$47.9 million in 2016. Cumulative production for vegetables and melons was 49.7 million pounds, a slight increase over last year's 49.3 million.

The top volume-producing vegetable crop during 2016 was head cabbage, whose estimated production was 8.66 million pounds, up 16 percent from 2015. Cucumbers were the second largest published vegetable volume crop, estimated at 5.6 million pounds, which is down 20 percent from the previous year.

In 2016, green onions had the largest percent increase of production from 2015, up 35 percent, as production went from 0.82 million pounds to 1.1 million pounds. The leading farm gate value was for cucumbers, estimated at \$5.64 million. Second largest was head cabbage, at \$4.55 million, up 20 percent from 2015.
