United States Commercial Slaughter

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.59 billion pounds in August 2024, down 2 percent from the 4.68 billion pounds produced in August 2023.

Beef production, at 2.29 billion pounds, was 3 percent below the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.70 million head, down 7 percent from August 2023.

Veal production totaled 3.10 million pounds, 26 percent below August a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 17,000 head, down 36 percent from August 2023.

Pork production totaled 2.29 billion pounds, down slightly from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 10.9 million head, down 2 percent from August 2023.

Lamb and mutton production, at 10.5 million pounds, was down 1 percent from August 2023. Sheep slaughter totaled 176,400 head, 4 percent below last year.

Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter

California's production of red meat during August 2024 totaled 94.3 million pounds (dressed weight), 15 percent below than August 2023. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In August 2024, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,349 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 147 pounds, and hogs averaged 229 pounds. In Hawaii, 800,000 pounds of red meat were produced in August 2024, and 100,000 pounds of red meat were produced in Nevada.
