United States Commercial Slaughter

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.45 billion pounds in September 2024, up 2 percent from the 4.35 billion pounds produced in September 2023.

Beef production, at 2.20 billion pounds, was 3 percent above the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.57 million head, down 1 percent from September 2023.

Veal production totaled 3.10 million pounds, 16 percent below September a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 16,100 head, down 26 percent from September 2023.

Pork production totaled 2.23 billion pounds, up 2 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 10.5 million head, up slightly from September 2023.

Lamb and mutton production, at 10.6 million pounds, was up 4 percent from September 2023. Sheep slaughter totaled 176,400 head, 1 percent above last year.

Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter

California's production of red meat during September 2024 totaled 89.1 million pounds (dressed weight), 11 percent below than September 2023. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In September 2024, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,372 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 155 pounds, and hogs averaged 230 pounds. In Hawaii, 700,000 pounds of red meat were produced in September 2024.
