# **United States Commercial Slaughter**

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.56 billion pounds in November 2024, down 3 percent from the 4.68 billion pounds produced in November 2023.

Beef production, at 2.22 billion pounds, was 3 percent below the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.57 million head, down 6 percent from November 2023.

Veal production totaled 3.10 million pounds, 28 percent below November a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 15,500 head, down 36 percent from November 2023.

Pork production totaled 2.33 billion pounds, down 2 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 10.8 million head, down 3 percent from November 2023.

Lamb and mutton production, at 10.4 million pounds, was down 7 percent from November 2023. Sheep slaughter totaled 173,600 head, 9 percent below last year.

## **Pacific Region Commercial Slaughter**

California's production of red meat during November 2024 totaled 90.6 million pounds (dressed weight), 13 percent below November 2023. This figure includes slaughter in Federally-inspected and state-inspected plants, but excludes farm slaughter. In November 2024, the average live weight of cattle slaughtered in California was 1,380 pounds, sheep and lambs averaged 142 pounds, and hogs averaged 236 pounds. In Hawaii, 700,000 pounds of red meat were produced in November 2024, and 100,000 pounds of red meat were produced in Nevada.
