## All Wheat Stocks Stored in Northwest Region Up 10 Percent from June 1, 2023

All wheat stored in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 24.4 million bushels in Idaho, up from 22.8 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 7 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 6 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, wheat stored in all positions totaled 15.3 million bushels, up from 11.8 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 34 percent, while on-farm stocks were unchanged compared to the previous year. In Washington, wheat stored in all positions totaled 50.7 million bushels, up from 47.7 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 10 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 31 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, wheat stored in all positions totaled 702 million bushels, up from 570 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 27 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 12 percent compared to the previous year.

**Barley** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 16.7 million bushels in Idaho, down from 20.8 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 26 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 4 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, barley stored in all positions totaled 508,000 bushels, up from 465,000 bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 11 percent, while on-farm stocks were unchanged from the previous year. In Washington, barley stored in all positions totaled 2.61 million bushels, up from 1.69 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 45 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 238 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, barley stored in all positions totaled 77.9 million bushels, up from 65.8 million bushels from a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 5 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 51 percent compared to the previous year.

**Oats** stored in off-farm locations on June 1, 2024 totaled 95,000 bushels in Idaho, up from 38,000 bushels a year ago. In Oregon, off-farm stocks totaled 80,000 bushels, down 19 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, oat stored in all positions totaled 76,000 bushels, up from 55,000 bushels a year ago. Nationally, oats stored in all positions totaled 36.3 million bushels, up from 34.8 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 17 percent from the previous year, while on-farm stocks were down 15 percent compared to the previous year.


**Corn** stored in off-farm locations on June 1, 2024 totaled 3.65 million bushels in Idaho, up 18 percent from the previous year. In Oregon, corn off-farm totaled 919,000 bushels, down 23 percent from a year ago. In Washington, corn stored in off-farm locations totaled 8.73 million bushels, up 11 percent from a year ago. Nationally, corn stored in all positions totaled 4.99 billion bushels, up from 4.10 billion bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 4 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 37 percent compared to the previous year.


