Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 875 million bushels, up 44 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 445 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 430 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 608 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 159 million bushels, up 46 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 66.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 92.6 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 174 million bushels.

Old crop all wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 13.9 million bushels, up 24 percent from June 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 1.30 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 12.6 million bushels. The March - May 2024 indicated disappearance is 16.9 million bushels.
