

CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

The total live weight of cattle and calves marketed during 2012 increased 33 percent from a year earlier. Cash receipts totaled \$361 million, up 45 percent from the \$248 million a year earlier. Gross income (cash receipts plus value of home consumption) increased 42 percent from a year earlier.

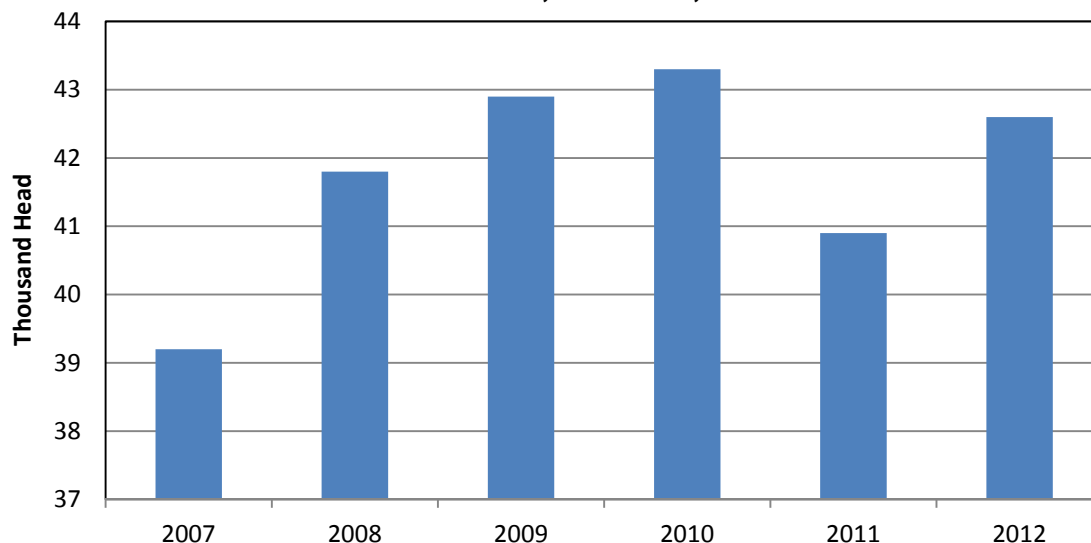

COMMERCIAL CATTLE SLAUGHTER NUMBER OF HEAD, INDIANA, 2007-2012



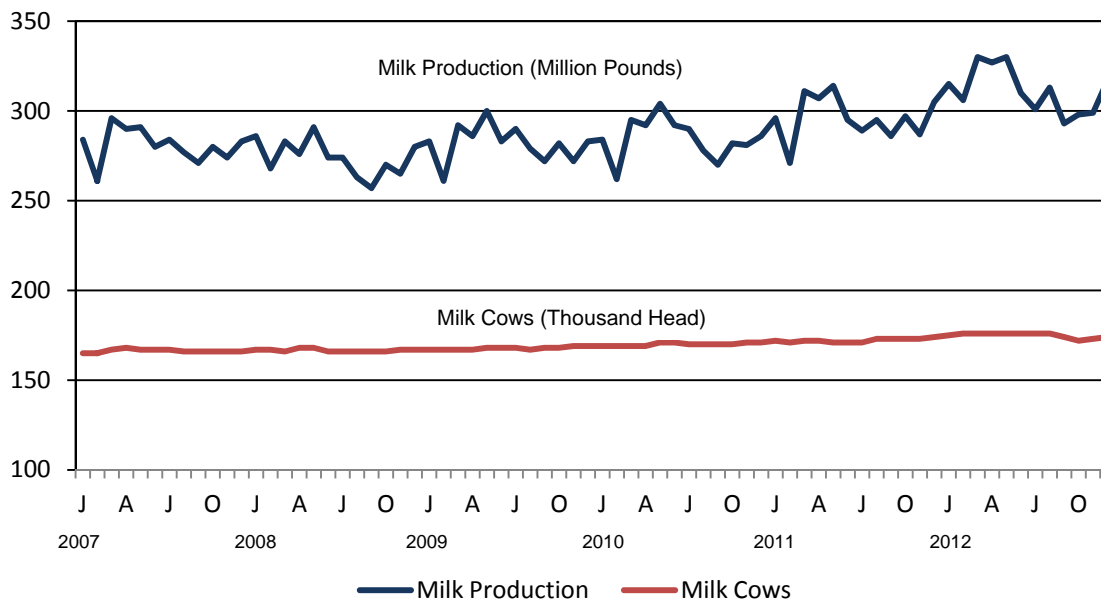
CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

Dairy farmers produced 3.7 billion pounds of milk during 2012, 5 percent above last year and 9 percent above 2010. Average number of milk cows increased to 175,000. Milk production per cow increased 3 percent to 21,366 pounds.
