

## CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

The total live weight of cattle and calves marketed during 2013 decreased 33 percent from a year earlier. Cash receipts totaled \$295 million, down 21 percent from the \$373 million a year earlier. Gross income (cash receipts plus value of home consumption) decreased 21 percent from a year earlier.

# CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

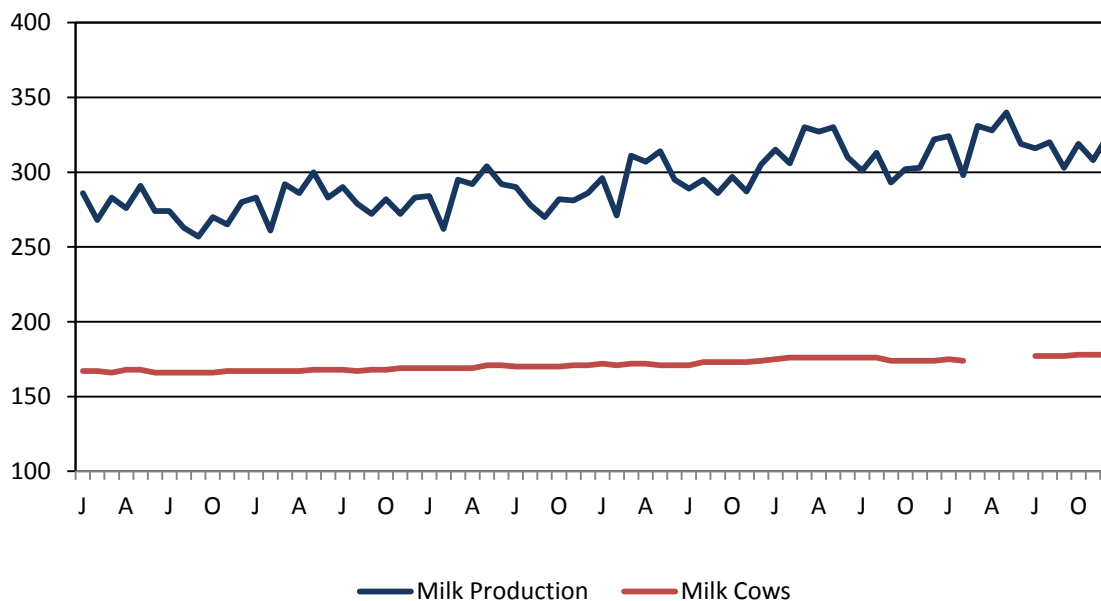
Dairy farmers produced 3.8 billion pounds of milk during 2013, 2 percent above last year and 8 percent above 2011. Average number of milk cows increased to 176,000. Milk production per cow increased 2 percent to 21,761 pounds.
