

CATTLE AND DAIRY PRODUCTS

The total live weight of cattle and calves marketed during 2017 increased 10 percent from a year earlier. Cash receipts totaled \$390 million, up 6 percent from the \$367 million a year earlier. Gross income (cash receipts plus value of home consumption), also increased 6 percent from a year earlier.

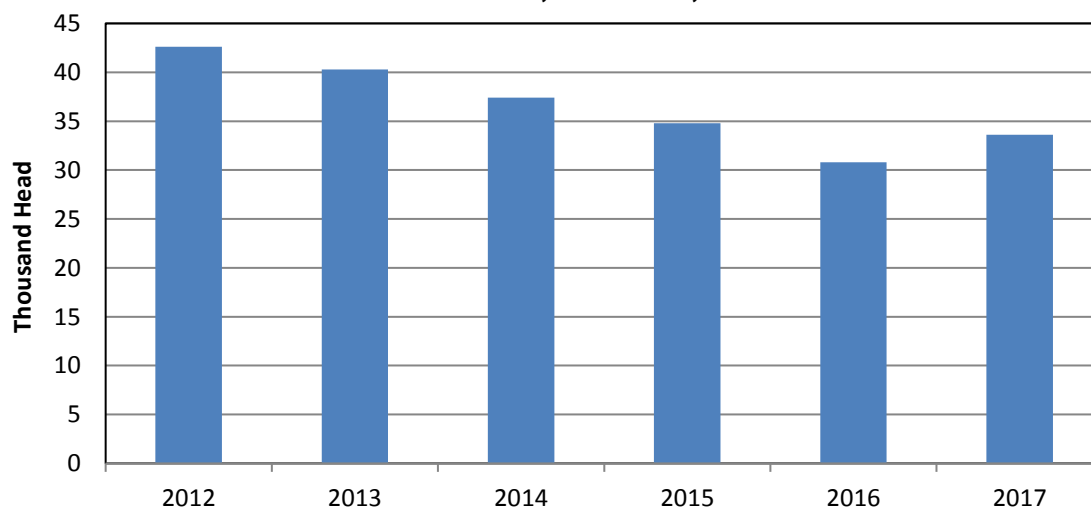
