The average price received by farmers for corn during May 2024 in Iowa was \$4.63 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – Agricultural Prices report. This was 13 cents above the April price but \$1.94 below May 2023.

The May 2024 average price received by farmers for soybeans, at \$11.90 per bushel, was 20 cents below the April price and \$2.60 below the May 2023 price.

All hay prices in Iowa averaged \$159.00 per ton in May. This was \$10.00 below the April price and \$14.00 below the May 2023 price. The May 2024 alfalfa hay price, at \$163.00, was \$14.00 below the previous month and \$15.00 below May 2023. The average price received for **other hay** during May was \$153.00 per ton. This was \$4.00 above the April price but \$8.00 below May last year.

The average price for milk was \$22.20 per cwt, \$3.20 above the April price and \$5.00 above May 2023.


