## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. January 2, 2020** - For the month of December 2019, topsoil moisture supplies rated 9 percent very short, 31 short, 56 adequate, and 4 surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 10 percent very short, 28 short, 60 adequate, and 2 surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 5 percent very poor, 16 poor, 39 fair, 36 good, and 4 excellent.

Cotton harvested was 97 percent.

The next monthly report (for January) will be issued January 27, 2020. Weekly reports will begin March 2<sup>nd</sup> for the 2020 season.
