## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. May 11, 2020** - For the week ending May 10, 2020, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 11 percent very short, 33 short, 52 adequate, and 4 surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 8 percent very short, 23 short, 67 adequate, and 2 surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 7 percent very poor, 17 poor, 38 fair, 33 good, and 5 excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 89 percent, near 86 last year. Headed was 39 percent, ahead of 29 last year, but behind 56 for the five-year average.

Corn planted was 61 percent, ahead of 45 last year, and near 58 average. Emerged was 29 percent, ahead of 23 last year, but near 32 average.

Soybeans planted was 23 percent, ahead of 6 last year and 11 average. Emerged was 6 percent, near 2 average.

Sorghum planted was 5 percent, near 1 last year and 2 average.

Cotton planted was 18 percent, ahead of 5 last year and 3 average.

Sunflowers planted was 2 percent, near 1 last year.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 3 percent very poor, 11 poor, 32 fair, 48 good, and 6 excellent.
