KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. July 15, 2024 - For the week ending July 14, 2024, there were 6.3 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 8% very short, 24% short, 63% adequate, and 5% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 6% very short, 28% short, 64% adequate, and 2% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat harvested was 97%, well ahead of 68% last year, and ahead of 86% for the five-year average.

Corn condition rated 3% very poor, 8% poor, 28% fair, 45% good, and 16% excellent. Corn silking was 59%, ahead of 50% last year and 45% average. Dough was 16%, ahead of 10% last year and 9% average.

Soybean condition rated 0% very poor, 3% poor, 21% fair, 59% good, and 17% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 39%, near 42% last year and 35% average. Setting pods was 8%, behind 14% last year, but near 7% average.

Sorghum condition rated 2% very poor, 6% poor, 37% fair, 44% good, and 11% excellent. Sorghum headed was 13%, near 11% last year and 9% average. Coloring was 3%, equal to last year, and near 1% average.

Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 7% poor, 29% fair, 46% good, and 18% excellent. Cotton squaring was 73%, ahead of 68% last year and 64% average. Setting bolls was 37%, well ahead of 10% last year and 8% average.

Sunflowers planted was 96%, near 92% last year and 94% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 8% poor, 29% fair, 49% good, and 10% excellent.
