KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. August 12, 2024 - For the week ending August 11, 2024, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 14% very short, 40% short, 44% adequate, and 2% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 13% very short, 43% short, 43% adequate, and 1% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Corn condition rated 8% very poor, 15% poor, 31% fair, 36% good, and 10% excellent. Corn silking was 95%, near 93% for both last year and the five-year average. Dough was 78%, ahead of 65% last year and 63% average. Dented was 32%, ahead of 20% last year and 21% average.

Soybean condition rated 3% very poor, 9% poor, 28% fair, 50% good, and 10% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 86%, near 89% last year and 82% average. Setting pods was 56%, behind 63% last year, but near 55% average.

Sorghum condition rated 6% very poor, 12% poor, 37% fair, 39% good, and 6% excellent. Sorghum headed was 70%, ahead of 58% last year and 57% average. Coloring was 20%, ahead of 11% last year and 9% average.

Cotton condition rated 1% very poor, 9% poor, 39% fair, 42% good, and 9% excellent. Cotton setting bolls was 84%, ahead of 77% last year, and well ahead of 63% average. Bolls opening was 8%, near 6% last year and 4% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 7% very poor, 16% poor, 34% fair, 37% good, and 6% excellent.
