## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. November 12, 2024** - For the week ending November 10, 2024, there were 3.0 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 5% very short, 21% short, 57% adequate, and 17% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 8% very short, 37% short, 47% adequate, and 8% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 10% poor, 39% fair, 39% good, and 8% excellent. Winter wheat planted was 97%, equal to last year, and near 96% for the five-year average. Emerged was 84%, near 85% last year and 81% average.

Corn harvested was 97%, near 96% last year and 94% average.

Soybeans harvested was 96%, ahead of 91% last year and 88% average.

Sorghum harvested was 88%, near 87% last year and 85% average.

Cotton harvested was 57%, near 58% last year, but ahead of 43% average.

Sunflowers harvested was 90%, ahead of 85% last year and 83% average.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 11% very poor, 21% poor, 45% fair, 22% good, and 1% excellent.
