KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 3, 2025 - For the week ending February 2, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 9% very short, 22% short, 63% adequate, and 6% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 11% very short, 28% short, 59% adequate, and 2% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 10% poor, 36% fair, 43% good, and 7% excellent.

The next report will be issued March 3, 2025.
