## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. March 3, 2025** - For the week ending March 2, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 10% very short, 25% short, 60% adequate, and 5% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 11% very short, 28% short, 58% adequate, and 3% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 10% poor, 32% fair, 46% good, and 8% excellent.
