KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 6, 2025 - For the week ending January 5, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 9% very short, 27% short, 60% adequate, and 4% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 12% very short, 30% short, 56% adequate, and 2% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 5% very poor, 11% poor, 37% fair, 40% good, and 7% excellent.

The next report will be issues February 3, 2025.
