KANSAS CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 12, 2023 - Based on May 1 conditions, Kansas's 2023 **winter wheat** crop is forecast at 191 million bushels, down 22% from last year's crop, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 29 bushels per acre, down 8 bushels from last year. Acreage to be harvested for grain is estimated at 6.60 million acres, unchanged from last year. This would be 81% of the planted acres, below last year's 90% harvested.

May 1 **hay** stocks of 740,000 tons are up 10% from last year.
