KANSAS CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

MANHATTAN, Kan. July 12, 2023 - Based on July 1 conditions, Kansas's **winter wheat** production is forecast at 208 million bushels, down 15% from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 32 bushels per acre, down 5 bushels from 2022. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 6.50 million acres, down 2% from a year ago.

Oat production is forecast at 1.10 million bushels, up 7% from last year. Average yield is forecast at 44 bushels per acre, up 3 bushels from 2022. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 25,000 acres, unchanged from a year ago.
