KANSAS CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 10, 2024 - Based on May 1 conditions, Kansas's 2024 winter wheat crop is forecast at 268 million bushels, up 33% from last year's crop, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 38 bushels per acre, up 3 bushels from last year. Acreage to be harvested for grain is estimated at 7.05 million acres, up 1.30 million acres from last year. This would be 92% of the planted acres, above last year's 71% harvested.

May 1 hay stocks of 1.25 million tons are up 74% from last year.
