## KANSAS CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

MANHATTAN, Kan. July 12, 2024 - Based on July 1 conditions, Kansas's winter wheat production is forecast at 307 million bushels, up 53% from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 43 bushels per acre, up 8 bushels from 2023. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 7.15 million acres, up 24% from a year ago.

Out production is forecast at 1.40 million bushels, down 29% from last year. Average yield is forecast at 40 bushels per acre, down 26 bushels from 2023. Area to be harvested for grain is estimated at 35,000 acres, up 17% from a year ago.
