KANSAS CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

MANHATTAN, Kan. November 8, 2024 - Based on November 1 conditions, Kansas's 2024 **corn** crop is forecast at 800 million bushels, up 31% from last year's production, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Area to be harvested for grain, at 5.80 million acres, is up 13% from a year ago. Yield is forecast at 138 bushels per acre, up 19 bushels from last year.

Sorghum for grain is forecast at 176 million bushels, up 4% from last year. Area for harvest, at 2.70 million acres, is down 17% from 2023. Yield is forecast at 65 bushels per acre, up 13 bushels from last year.

Soybean production is forecast at 170 million bushels, up 65% from last year. Area for harvest, at 4.48 million acres, is up 13% from 2023. Yield is forecast at 38 bushels per acre, up 12 bushels from last year.

Cotton production is forecast at 190,000 bales, up 28% from last year. Acreage for harvest, at 120,000 acres, is up 26,000 acres from 2023. Yield is forecast at 760 pounds per acre, down 1 pound per acre from a year ago.
