## KANSAS JUNE 1, 2024 GRAIN STOCKS

**MANHATTAN, Kan. June 28, 2024** - Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2024 totaled 155 million bushels, up 6% from 2023, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 65.0 million bushels are stored on farms, up 71% from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 90.2 million bushels, are down 17% from last year.

**Wheat** stored in all positions totaled 121 million bushels, up 29% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 4.90 million bushels are up 2% from 2023, and off-farm stocks of 116 million bushels are up 30% from last year.

**Sorghum** stored in all positions totaled 32.7 million bushels, down 5% from 2023. On-farm stocks of 3.35 million bushels are down 29% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks of 29.4 million bushels are down 1% from last year.

**Soybeans** stored in all positions totaled 30.5 million bushels, down 9% from last year. On-farm stocks of 13.5 million bushels are up 29% from a year ago, but off-farm stocks, at 17.0 million bushels, are down 26% from 2023.

Off farm **oat** stocks totaled 725,000 bushels, down 16% from last year.
