KANSAS JANUARY 1 CATTLE INVENTORY

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 31, 2025 - All cattle and calves in Kansas as of January 1, 2025 totaled 5.95 million head, down 3% from January 1, 2024, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

All cows and heifers that had calved totaled 1.41 million head, unchanged from last year.

Beef cows totaled 1.23 million head, down slightly from last year.

Milk cows totaled 180,000 head, up 3% from January 1, 2024.

All heifers 500 pounds and over totaled 1.81 million head, down 8% from last year.

Steers weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 2.05 million head, down 1% from last year.

Bulls weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 80,000 head, unchanged from last year.

Calves under 500 pounds totaled 600,000 head, down 3% from January 1, 2024.

All cattle on feed fed for slaughter in Kansas feedlots totaled 2.50 million head, down 4% from the previous year.

The **2024 calf crop** totaled 1.30 million head, up 1% from 2023.
