KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED DOWN SLIGHTLY

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 21, 2022 - Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.49 million cattle on feed on January 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down slightly from last year.

Placements during December totaled 450,000 head, up 2% from 2020.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of December totaled 430,000 head, up 1% from last year.

Other disappearance during December totaled 10,000 head, down 5,000 head from last year.
