KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED UP 1%

MANHATTAN, Kan. April 22, 2022 - Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.51 million cattle on feed on April 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 1% from last year.

Placements during March totaled 490,000 head, unchanged from 2021.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of March totaled 480,000 head, up 2% from last year.

Other disappearance during March totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
