## KANSAS HOG INVENTORY DOWN 1%

**MANHATTAN, Kan. September 26, 2024 - Kansas inventory** of all hogs and pigs on September 1, 2024, was 1.98 million head, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This was down 1% from September 1, 2023, and down 2% from June 1, 2024.

**Breeding hog inventory**, at 170,000 head, was down 3% from September 1, 2023, but unchanged from last quarter. **Market hog inventory**, at 1.81 million head, was down slightly from last year, and down 2% from last quarter.

**The June - August 2024 Kansas pig crop**, at 1.01 million head, was up 4% from 2023. Sows farrowed during the period totaled 85,000 head, down 2% from last year. The average pigs saved per litter was 11.90 for the June - August period, compared to 11.20 last year.

**Kansas hog producers** intend to farrow 85,000 sows during the September - November 2024 quarter, up 2% from the actual farrowings during the same period a year ago. Intended farrowings for December 2024 - February 2025 are 78,000 sows, down 8% from the actual farrowings during the same period a year ago.
