KANSAS MILK PRODUCTION

MANHATTAN, Kan. December 19, 2024 - Milk production in Kansas during November 2024 totaled 351 million pounds, up 3% from November 2023, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 181,000 head, 5,000 head more than November 2023. Milk production per cow averaged 1,940 pounds.
