## **Louisiana Crop Progress and Condition Report**

Week Ending September 20, 2015

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 6.6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 20, 2015. Topsoil moisture supplies were 25 percent very short, 29 percent short, 45 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 21 percent very short, 26 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 55.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Calhoun to 70.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Morgan City. Highs ranged from 84.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Homer to 92.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Alexandria. Warm dry weather conditions were prevalent throughout most of the state, with the highest rain concentration in the southwest and south central part of the state with an average of 0.03 inches.

## **Comments from Cooperative Extension Service Parish Agents**

"Soybean harvest continuing, cotton harvest has begun, sweet potato harvest slow due to dry soil conditions. Pastures need rain and planting of winter forage will be delayed if it does not rain soon."

"Clearer weather with excellent drying conditions has allowed much fieldwork. Hay baling is wide open as is the plowing of ground for ryegrass planting. Herbicide and fertilizer applications following baling in efforts to correct weed problems developed earlier in our prolonged wet spring. Rice harvest essentially complete with exception of late planted crawfish pond, pulling of levees and plowing for next year's fields underway. Earlier planted soybeans receiving harvest aid herbicide applications, while later planted beans receiving insecticide applications primarily for stinkbugs."

"Plenty of sunshine this week and first soybeans are being harvested. Seeing aerial blight and frog-eye in soybeans. Fall vegetables are off to a good start. Livestock is looking good."
