According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 6.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 29, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 12 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 13 percent short, 76 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus.
