Corn Yield and Production Unchanged from October Cotton Yield and Production Up from October Rice Yield and Production Unchanged from October Soybean Yield and Production Unchanged from October Sugarcane Yield and Production Down from October

Louisiana **corn** for grain production is forecast at 84.1 million bushels, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but down 29 percent from 2023. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is expected to average 189 bushels per acre, unchanged from last month but up 14 bushels from last year. Producers expect to harvest 445,000 acres of corn for grain, down 235,000 acres from 2023.

**Upland cotton** production is forecast at 310,000 bales, up 10,000 bales from the October 1 forecast and 101,000 bales above last year. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is expected to average 992 pounds per harvested acre, up 32 pounds from last month and up 120 pounds from 2023. Harvested acreage is estimated at 150,000 acres, up 35,000 acres from 2023.

All rice production for the state is forecast at 31.0 million hundredweight, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but down 1 percent from last year's production of 31.4 million hundredweight. Based on conditions as of November 1, the all rice yield for 2024 is forecast at 6,650 pounds per acre, unchanged from last month but down 150 pounds from last year. Producers expect to harvest 466,000 acres, up 4,000 acres from 2023.

**Soybean** production in 2024 is forecast at 55.1 million bushels, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but up 41 percent from last year. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is expected to average 52 bushels per acre, unchanged from last month but up 12 bushels from last year. Area for harvest, at 1.06 million acres, is up 80,000 acres from 2023.

**Sugarcane** production is forecast at 16.6 million net tons, down 1 percent from the October 1 forecast but up 9 percent from a year ago. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is forecast at 32.0 net tons per acre, down 0.2 net ton from last month but up 1.9 net tons from last year. Area harvested for sugar and seed totaled 520,000 acres, up 14,500 acres from 2023.
