#### 2024 Louisiana Total Value of Production for Field Crops Down 7 Percent

The value of production for field crops in Louisiana during 2024 totaled \$2.71 billion, down 7 percent from 2023. The top three crop commodities (excluding sugarcane), soybeans, rice, and corn, accounted for 51 percent of the total value of production for field crops. All Hay showed the largest increase at 26 percent in value of production from last year, followed by cotton at 23 percent. Corn showed the largest percentage decrease from 2023 at 50 percent, followed by rice at 13 percent.

At the national level, the value of production for field crops was down 10 percent, at \$168 billion, from 2023. Corn, at \$64.7 billion, was the leading field crop followed by soybeans at \$44.1 billion and all hay at \$18.6 billion.




