Rough Rice Stocks Down 12 Percent

Louisiana **rough rice** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2024, totaled 13.1 million hundredweight (cwt), down 12 percent from December 1, 2023. Stocks held on farms totaled 6.20 million cwt, up 2 percent from a year ago. Off farm stocks totaled 6.90 million cwt, down 22 percent from last year.

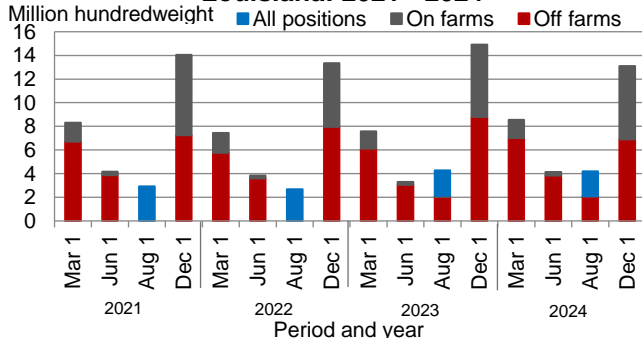

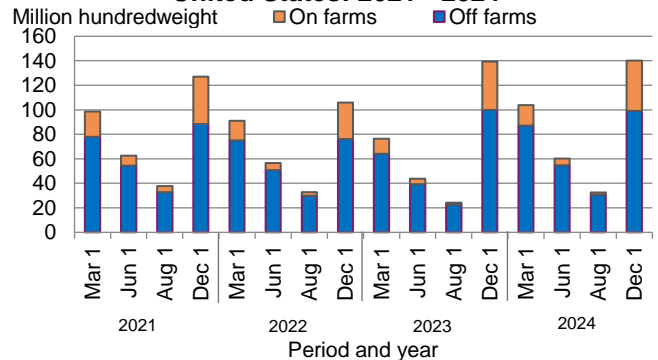

Grain Stocks - December 1, 2024

Louisiana **corn** stocks at off farm grain storage facilities on December 1, 2024, totaled 24.4 million bushels, down 11 percent from December 1, 2023. **Oat** stocks at off farm storage facilities totaled 13,000 bushels. **All wheat** stocks at off farm storage facilities totaled 5.21 million bushels, down 11 percent from a year ago.

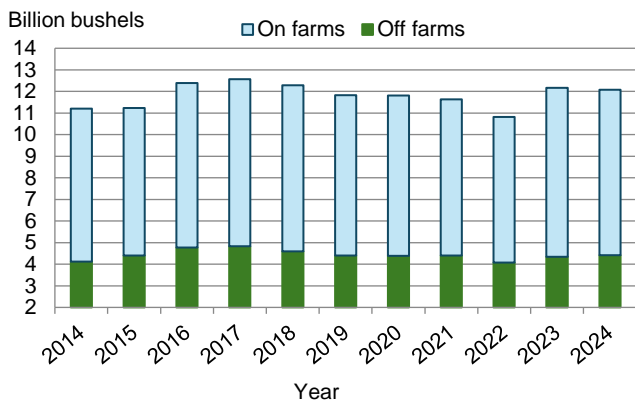

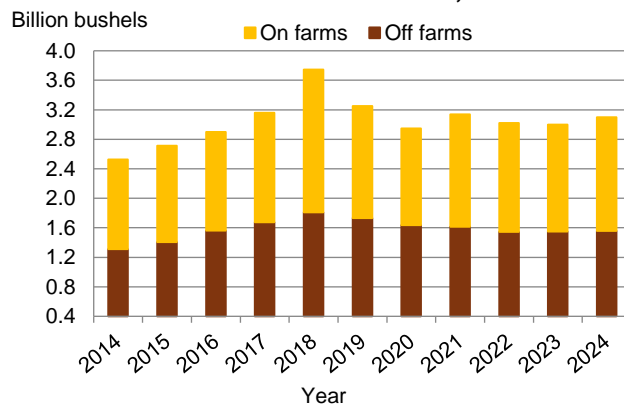
